FOR EVERY WOMAN **MOBILE MEDICAL CLINIC**LAUNCH IN ORANGE COUNTY

In an exciting step forward, Save the Storks, our platform For Every Woman, and the Orange County Rescue Mission launched the first For Every Woman Mobile Medical Clinic in the U.S. This project is a dream two years in the making. The launch marks a significant milestone in the mission to support women across Southern California. Additionally, it will connect more women with our online platform For Every Woman.

The mobile medical clinic plans to operate eight hours daily, five to six days a week. This means it could serve **2,500** to **3,500** women in its first year. It will begin by serving areas in Orange, Santa Ana, and the OC Rescue Mission. In the future, it plans to expand to Anaheim and other neighboring cities.

MOBILE MEDICAL CLINIC DELIVERIES

The Mobile Operations Team has delivered two new Mobile Medical Clinics, aka Stork Buses, and rehomed four MMCs, ensuring they stay on the road serving women and saving lives. So far in 2024, two new MMCs have been ordered and are expected to be delivered this fall. One of our partners, CompassCare, located in New York City, had this to say about how our mobile medical clinic impacted a young woman's life, and the tragic reality of abortion in NYC:

"In New York County (Manhattan), for every 100 black babies born, 116 are aborted! NYC is the most difficult place in the nation to save women and babies from abortion. In May, CompassCare launched a Save the Storks Mobile Medical Clinic in the Bronx, serving women right where they are. A young woman named Kayla who discovered she was pregnant came on board. The ultrasound revealed a healthy 10-week-old baby. Kayla's nurse also had a chance to present the Gospel, she surrendered her life to Jesus. Many women are hearing the Gospel of Jesus Christ in the mobile medical clinic, with nearly 80% of them submitting to Jesus as their Savior! Unbelievable, right?"





EQUAL ACCESS TO MOTHERHOODSM

In April, Save the Storks launched its new campaign, Equal Access to MotherhoodSM.

Equal Access to MotherhoodSM is a movement to empower every woman with the practical support and care she deserves. It's about **breaking** down barriers to life-affirming maternal care for women with the least access... and empowering them with REAL choice to be the type of moms they most aspire to be—whether through raising a child, choosing adoption, or fostering.

STAND FOR LIFE

Save the Storks has been an integral part of Stand for Life, a collaboration of life-affirming organizations, as a core team member. Along with other organizations like Live Action, Human Coalition, Heartbeat International, Embrace Grace, Lifeline Children's Services, and Alliance Defending Freedom, this Stand for Life team aims to connect, unify, and mobilize the Church to affirm and protect the dignity of all human life. 
NATIONAL PARTNER PROGRAM

The National Partner Program works with over 130 Pregnancy Clinics throughout the United States. We have added 11 new partners so far this year, bringing total partners to 97, to support them in elevating services through medical excellence, mobile, marketing, and more! Our team serves clinics by helping them stay ahead of upcoming legislation, pursuing Accreditation Association of Ambulatory Health Care (AAAHC), and providing the training needed to become the go-to source for women's health through mobile and beyond.

The Save the Storks Team made a significant impact at the annual Seek 24 conference, where we joined over 23,000 college students and parishioners in January. Our booth attracted hundreds of students who enthusiastically participated in our engaging "Beat the Pro" soccer kick-up contest featuring Luke Vercollone, Save the Storks' employee and former pro-soccer player. Participants competed for Save the Storks t-shirts and hats, which they all wore eagerly.

During our Impact Session titled "From Pro-soccer to Pro-life," we were thrilled to welcome **258** students. Through these interactive activities and Impact Session, we effectively educated students about Save the Storks and our For Every Woman initiative. This not only deepened their understanding of our organization but also inspired them to consider their role in promoting life within their communities through partnership with us.

Overall, our presence at Seek 24 was a resounding success, empowering a new wave of advocates for life and spreading awareness of our mission to a diverse and enthusiastic audience.



CHURCH TEAM IMPACTING LIVES THROUGH PARTNERSHIPS

The Stork Mothers Advocate Program, launched last year, provides a way for churches to train their volunteers to serve moms by being their advocate between Pregnancy Health Clinics, local organizations, and the Church. The goal is to help connect the mom to a loving community in the local church through relationships and trust. With this program, the Church Team recently trained high-level volunteers at a church in Irvine, California, who will be mobilizing these volunteers to reach out and help moms in need in their community.

Recently, the team was at a church in Long Beach sharing about Save the Storks. An older woman came to the table with tears in her eyes, sharing that she had an abortion over 40 years ago and has never been healed from it and thinks about it daily. One of our church team members was able to spend time with her and talk with her about one of our strategic partners, Deeper Still, which offers retreats for post-abortive care. She prayed for the woman and her husband as well as connected her to a much-needed resource for help, hope, and healing.
